(3rd Declension): Consonant Stem: fūr fūr-is (3m.) 'thief'					
<i>nominative (Singular)</i>	fūr	'thief'	<i>nominative (Plural)</i>	fūr-es	'thieves'
<i>vocative (Singular)</i>	fūr	'thief'	<i>vocative (Plural)</i>	fūr-es	'O thieves'
<i>accusative (Singular)</i>	fūr-em	'thief'	<i>accusative (Plural)</i>	fūr-es	'thieves'
<i>genitive (Singular)</i>	fūr-is	'of the thief'	<i>genitive (Plural)</i>	fūr-um	'of thieves'
<i>dative (Singular)</i>	fūr-ī	'to/for the thief'	<i>dative (Plural)</i>	fūr-ibus	'to/for thieves'
<i>ablative (Singular)</i>	fūr-e	'by/with/from the thief'	<i>ablative (Plural)</i>	fūr-ibus	'by/with/from thieves'
(3rd Declension): i-stem: aedis aed-is (3f.) 'room' / 'temple'; in plural 'temples', 'house'					
<i>nominative (Singular)</i>	aéd-is	'room', 'temple'	<i>nominative (Plural)</i>	aéd-ēs	'temples'/'house'
<i>vocative (Singular)</i>	aéd-is	'O room', 'O temple'	<i>vocative (Plural)</i>	aéd-ēs	'O temples'/'O house'
<i>accusative (Singular)</i>	aéd-em	'room', 'temple'	<i>accusative (Plural)</i>	aéd-is	'temples'/'house'
<i>genitive (Singular)</i>	aéd-is	'of the room', 'of the temple'	<i>genitive (Plural)</i>	aéd-ium	'of temples'/'of the house'
<i>dative (Singular)</i>	aéd-ī	'to/for the room/temple'	<i>dative (Plural)</i>	aéd-ibus	'to/for temples/the house'
<i>ablative (Singular)</i>	aéd-e	'by/with/from the room/temple'	<i>ablative (Plural)</i>	aéd-ibus	by/with/from temples/the house
