<i>1st Singular</i>	é-ō	'I go', 'I come', 'I am going/coming', I do go/come'.
<i>2nd Singular</i>	ī-s	'You go', 'You come', 'You are going/coming'
<i>3rd Singular</i>	i-t	'He/she/it goes/comes', 'He/she/it is going/is coming'
<i>1st Plural</i>	ī-mus	'We go', 'We come', 'We are going/ coming'
<i>2nd Plural</i>	ī-tis	'You go', 'You come', 'You are going/coming'
<i>3rd Plural</i>	é-u-nt	'They go', 'They come', 'They are going/coming'

Imperatives are - (2nd s.) - **ī** 'Go!', 'Come!' 'You are going/coming!'
